What are Specialty Courts?

- Alternative courts focused on treatment and rehabilitation
- Genesee County Specialty Courts:
 - Adult Felony Recovery Court
 - Mental Health Court
 - Veterans Treatment Court
 - Family Dependency Treatment Court
- Goal: Address root causes, reduce recidivism



Why Specialty Courts Matter



Reduce re-arrest rates by up to 45%

- Recovery Court 14%
- Michigan State Rate –23%



Save \$3 to \$6 for every \$1 invested

Our recovery court saved
~\$3 million in 2024



Save county jail bed days

 Saved 52,480 jail days in 2024

Federal Funding Climate



Uncertainty



Restructuring and funding cuts



Cannot predict future funding forecast

Current Challenges

Limited drug testing options

Inability to detect emerging drugs (e.g., xylazine, ketamine) Gaps in monitoring jeopardize program success

The Risk of Inaction



Increased relapse rates



Higher public safety risks



Erosion of court program credibility

Our Proposal

- Requesting Funds to:
 - Expand drug testing capabilities
 - Enact more frequent testing
 - Obtain broader substance panels
 - Obtain faster lab results

Cost-Benefit Snapshot

Expanded testing cost: \$50,000
