

## AMENDMENT TO GREEN FOR LIFE ENVIRONMENTAL

This Amendment is between Genesee County, Michigan, a Michigan municipal corporation whose principal place of business is located at 1101 Beach Street, Flint, Michigan 48502 (the "County"), and Green for Life Environmental, whose principal place of business is located at 26999 Central Park Blvd., Suite 200, Southfield, MI 48076-4145 (the "Contractor") (the Contractor and the County together, the "Parties").

WHEREAS, the Parties executed a Professional Services Contract effective June 2, 2021 (the "Contract"), pursuant to which the Contractor would provide solid waste removal/disposal and recycling services; and

WHEREAS, the Genesee County Board of Commissioners authorized the original contract by Resolution # 2021-371; and

WHEREAS, the Genesee County Board of Commissioners authorized the first of two (2) one-year extensions of said contract by Resolution # 2024-1202 on October 23, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to amend the contract by exercising the option to extend it for one additional year by using the last one-year extension. The new expiration date of the contract will be September 30, 2026.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

1. **The Contractor will perform the following work:**

- Be responsible for the collection, transportation, and disposal of solid waste and recyclable waste generated at designated facilities in accordance with all local, state, and federal laws.
- Collect solid waste materials and recyclable waste generated at each designated facility in the sizes and locations listed in Exhibit A of this amendment. The contractor shall maintain all containers (including lids) in good and working condition and shall, at the Contractor's expense, replace any containers, or lids that are shown to be in poor condition.
- Collect solid waste on a regularly scheduled basis as determined by the County and agreed upon by the Contractor. Certain containers shall be placed on "will call" status in off seasons, as determined by the County.
- Maintain a clean area around dumpsters, including picking up and removing any debris created as a result of the collection activity.
- Be able to respond to any irregularities in waste generation. The Contractor shall respond within 24 hours to any unforeseen/special pickups requested by the County.

- The County will be billed monthly based on the attached rate schedule that is labeled "Exhibit A" for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.

2. The remaining terms of the agreement remain unchanged and in full effect.
